## Isolated Severe Storms & Flash Flooding Possible Today through Friday

### Situation Overview

Marginal Risk across most of Tri-State Area (Thurs)

**Threats**

- Isolated Damaging Wind Gusts up to 60 mph.
- A couple tornadoes are possible.
- Hail, some of which could be quarter sized.

**Timing**

Thunderstorms may occur anytime, with the severe potential peaking during the afternoon and evening.

Higher Threat and Coverage for Severe Storms

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### Severe Weather Outlook

- Isolated strong to severe storms continue today and this evening.
- Main threats: damaging wind gusts, and quarter-size hail. A couple tornadoes possible.
- Additional threats are frequent lightning and pockets of heavy rainfall.

### Rainfall/Other Hazards

**FLASH FLOOD THREAT CONTINUES TODAY**  
Much of the Tri-State Area is under a risk for excessive rainfall

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**Threats**

<b>MARGINAL (MRGL)</b> Isolated flash floods possible Localized and primarily affecting places that can experience rapid runoff with heavy rainfall.	<b>SLIGHT (SLGT)</b> Scattered flash floods possible Mainly localized. Most vulnerable are urban areas, roads, small streams and washes. Isolated significant flash floods possible.	<b>MODERATE (MDT)</b> Numerous flash floods likely Numerous flash flooding events with significant events possible. Many streams may flood, substantially affecting larger areas.
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Highest forecast amounts thru Friday are 3-4 inches along the coastal Panhandle

Avoid flooded roads!

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### Excessive Rainfall Outlook

- Much of the Tri-State area is under a risk for excessive rainfall.
- The most vulnerable locations are the FL Panhandle where a Flood Watch is in effect until tonight.
- A Moderate Risk (level 3 of 4) for excessive rainfall is in place for mainly the coastal Panhandle.
- Gulf County is especially susceptible to flash flooding given yesterday's rainfall.
- Forecast amounts through Friday are up to 3-4 inches (isolated 4-8 inches).
